

DETAILED ITINERARY

04:00am-5:00am: Pick up from your establishment in Cape Town. 05:00am-8:00am: Flight from Cape Town International Airport to O.R Tambo International Airport (upon arrival at O.R Tambo our driver/guide will be waiting for you at domestic arrivals with a board bearing your name).

<u>08:00am-13:00pm</u>: Travel from Johannesburg to Mpumalanga (travel time 4 hours and 30 minutes with a stop at Middelburg for bathroom and coffee at own cost)

<u>13:30pm-17:00pm:</u> Kruger National Park Afternoon Safari.

<u>About Full Day Safari</u>

- Upon traveling to the Kruger National Park, you will be treated to the most beautiful scenery in Mpumalanga through meanders than wind and beacon one to look out the window and soak in the beauty of nature.
- Kruger National Park is located in the beautiful province of Mpumalanga in South Africa and is one of the biggest game reserves in Africa, home to the BIG 5: lion, buffalo, rhino, elephant, and leopards.
- Kruger National Park is the largest National Park in South Africa and the first one to ever be established in the year 1926.
- Not only is it home to the big five, but it is also an epicenter for reptiles and bird life having at least 517 bird species, 114 Reptile species and 147 large mammal species.
- Kruger National Park, besides being a haven for wildlife, it is also home to not one but 6 different rivers that run through the park such as Sable, Olifants, Crocodile, Letaba, Luvuvhu, and the Limpopo River giving one backdrops and watering holes that animals frequently drink.
- Enjoy this afternoon safari with a visit to Skukuza to grab a bit to eat before heading out to check into your overnight accommodation in Hazy View.

<u>05:00am-16:00pm: Kruger National Park Full Day Safari</u>

<u>About the Full Day Safari</u>

- With departure from the accommodation estimated at 5.30 am. This promises to be the climax of our wildlife experience. The Kruger National full Day safari!
- An early morning safari provides an opportunity to see what wildlife does in the morning, particularly the cat family, which is constantly on the quest for their next meal. Various creatures will return from hunts, and this is the ideal time to witness them in action.
- We will arrive at the nearest gate, ready to be ushered early in the morning and experience wildlife at the various stages of the day. We will explore the park for the whole day with a quick popping to have breakfast and Lunch at the famous Skukuza Camp Located inside the Kruger National Park.
- Our day will end at around 4 pm when we depart from the park and head back to our accommodation in Hazy View and reflect on the wonderful day we had.

<u>About the Morning Safari</u>

- We will rise early in the morning for our morning safari and get ready to jump inside the park as earliest as possible to get a feel of what this wildlife does in the wee hours of the morning.
- This also serves us an opportunity to see what wildlife does in the morning and especially the cat family who are always hunting their next meal. Various creatures will be coming back from hunts, and this will be the perfect time to see them in action.
- We will also get an opportunity to have our pre -packed breakfast prepared from the hotel and experience the best 4 hours in the morning.

<u>10:00am-11:00am</u>: Return to overnight accommodation to collect luggage and check out. <u>11:00am – 16:00 pm</u>: Travel from Kruger National Park (with one pit stop for bathroom and lunch at own cost at Middleburg) to Johannesburg

<u>16:00pm-20:30pm:</u> Upon arrival in Johannesburg, catch your flight back to Cape Town. When arriving in Cape Town International Airport, an Africa Moja shuttle service will be waiting to take you to your destination.

• Traveling to the Kruger National Park takes about 4 hours and 30 minutes.
