05:00am-05:30am: Pick up from your establishment in Johannesburg, Pretoria, and Sandton.

05:30am- 10:00am: Travel to Kruger National Park (with one pit stop for bathroom and breakfast at own cost at Middleburg)

10:00am-15:00pm: Kruger National Park Safari

About Kruger National Park Safari

- Kruger National Park is located in the beautiful province of Mpumalanga in South Africa and is one of the biggest Game Reserves in Africa, home to the BIG 5: lion, buffalo, rhino, elephant, and leopards.
- Upon traveling to Kruger National Park, you will be treated to the most beautiful scenery in Mpumalanga with meanders than wind and beacon one to look out the window and soak in the beauty of nature.
- We will arrive at the nearest gate, ready to be ushered by our safari guide in the morning and experience the wildlife at the various stages of the day. We will explore the park for the whole day with a quick pop in to have lunch (at own cost) at the famous Skukuza Camp Located inside the Kruger National Park.
- Kruger National Park is the largest National Park in South Africa and the first one to ever be established in the year 1926.
- Not only home to the big five it's also an epicenter for reptiles and bird life having at least 517 bird species, 114 Reptile species and 147 large mammal species.
- Kruger National Park besides being a haven for wildlife is also home to not one but 6 different rivers that run through the park such as Sable, Olifants, Crocodile, Letaba, Luvuvhu, and the Limpopo River giving one backdrops and watering holes that animals frequent.
