<u>Day 1 - Arrival - Johannesburg - Sky Hotel Sandton</u>

- Be welcome on arrival at OR Tambo International Airport by an Africa Moja personnel to begin your 4 Days Johannesburg Tour with Kruger 2 Days Safari

<u>Day 2 - Johannesburg - Johannesburg, Soweto, and Apartheid Museum Tour</u>

About Johannesburg, Soweto, And Apartheid

Mandela House, Houghton

The first attraction we will start at is the Mandela house in Houghton. This is where former President Nelson Mandela lived with his wife, Graca Machel in 1998 towards the end of his presidency. We will drive next stop from the Mandela house is the Constitutional Hill, we will drive to this attraction through the Munro Road for a panoramic view of the Johannesburg city.

The Constitutional Hill

The Constitutional Hill is a site of incarceration in South Africa that imprisoned a number of renowned men and women within its wall Old Fort, Womens Jail and Number Four. Nelson Mandela, Mahatma Ghandi, Winnie Madikizela, Joe Slovo and so many others were imprisoned in this jail and this place is now museum. This museum now tells the story of the state of the prison, the role it played in South African History and what it currently stands for now post-apartheid. Nelson Mandela was held in this prison during the famous treason trial of 1956.

Soweto

From Constitutional Hill we will head straight to Soweto, we will pass by Bree taxi rank and the Mandela bridge. On our way to our main attractions in Soweto we will pass by Diep Sloot, this is one of the famous townships in Soweto. From Diep Sloot we will pass by Baragwanath hospital, this is the largest hospital in South Africa and third largest in the world. Just next to the hospital there is Baragwanath taxi rank, this is where people commute from and to their desired destinations From Baragwanath we will pass by one of the most prominent landmarks in Soweto. The Soweto Towers, a decommissioned coal-fired power station now serving as an advertising billboard and an adventure center for activities such as Bungee jumping, free fall, paint balling etc. then from here we will head to Vilakazi street the most famous street in the world. It is the only street in the world that ever lived two noble price winners Desmond Tutu and Nelson Mandela house.

Mandela House

The Nelson Mandela House or Mandela House is the house located on Vilakazi Street Orlando West Soweto in South Africa and was the residential house where Nelson Mandela lived from 1946 up until 1962 with his family. Located on 8115 at the corner of Vilakazi street and Ngakane street this house is not far from the Tutu house which was also the residential home of Archbishop Desmond Tutu. From the Mandela house we will go visit the Hector Pieterson Memorial

<u>Hector Pieterson Memorial</u>

Hector Pieterson Museum will give us some inspiration on the language of resistance in the uprising of 1976 Hector across Soweto. The Hector Pietersen Museum is located in Orlando West in Soweto, two blocks away from where Hector Pietersen was shot and killed on 16 June 1976. The museum is named in his honor and covers the events of the anti- apartheid uprising of Soweto and the battle for anti-apartheid laws of having Afrikaans compulsory in all schools across South Africa. From the Hector Pietersen Memorial we will go to the Apartheid Museum, and we will pass by FNB stadium which is one of the biggest stadiums in South Africa.

<u>Apartheid Museum</u>

The Apartheid Museum is last our stop where we get a true and final depiction on the magnitude of the Apartheid regime and the role Nelson Mandela, and his peers played in overcoming it. The Apartheid Museum Tour shows how South Africa was before apartheid ended in 1994. The Museum has about 22 exhibitions with each highlighting the various struggles during the Apartheid era. The Exhibitions include the Nelson Mandela Release and the Mandela Presidency amongst the others.



DETAILED ITINERARY

<u>Day 3 - Johannesburg - Hazy View - Kruger National Park</u>

About Kruger National Park Safari

- Kruger National Park is located in the beautiful province of Mpumalanga in South Africa and is one of the biggest Game Reserves in Africa home to the BIG 5: lion, buffalo, rhino, elephant, and leopards.
- Upon traveling to Kruger National Park, you will be treated to the most beautiful scenery in Mpumalanga with meanders than wind and beacon one to look out the window and soak in the beauty of nature.
- Kruger National Park is the largest National Park in South Africa and the first one to ever be established in the year 1926.
- Not only home to the big five it's also an epicenter for reptiles and bird life having at least 517 bird species, 114 Reptile species and 147 large mammal species.
- Kruger National Park besides being a haven for wildlife is also home to not one but 6 different rivers that run through the park such as Sable, Olifants, Crocodile, Letaba, Luvuvhu, and the Limpopo River giving one backdrops and watering holes that animals frequent.
- Enjoy this afternoon safari with a visit to Skukuza to grab a bit to eat before heading out to check into your overnight accommodation.

<u>Day 4 - Hazy View - Kruger National Park - Johannesburg</u>

<u>About Kruger National Park Safari</u>
