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# DETAILED ITINERARY

### <u>Day 1</u>

<u>06:00am-7:00am:</u> Pick up from your establishment in Johannesburg, Pretoria, and Sandton.

<u>07:00am-12:00am:</u> Travel to Kruger National Park (with one pit stop for bathroom and coffee at own cost at Middleburg)

Travelling to the Kruger National Park takes about 4 hours and 30 minutes. <u>12:00am-17:00pm</u>; Kruger National Park Afternoon Safari

#### <u>About Kruger National Park Safari</u>

- Upon traveling to the Kruger National Park, you will be treated to the most beautiful scenery in Mpumalanga through meanders than wind and beacon one to look out the window and soak in the beauty of nature.
- Kruger National Park is located in the beautiful province of Mpumalanga in South Africa and is home to the BIG 5: lion, buffalo, rhino, elephant, and leopards.
- Kruger National Park is the largest National Park in South Africa and the first one to ever be established in the year 1926.
- Not only is it home to the big five, but it is also an epicenter for reptiles and bird life having at least 517 bird species, 114 Reptile species and 147 large mammal species.
- Kruger National Park, besides being a haven for wildlife, it is also home to 6 different rivers that run through the park such as Sable, Olifants, Crocodile, Letaba, Luvuvhu, and the Limpopo River giving one backdrop and watering holes that animals frequently drink.
- Enjoy this afternoon safari with a visit to Skukuza to grab a bit to eat before heading out to check into your overnight accommodation.

### <u>Day 2</u>

#### 05:00am-16:00pm: Kruger National Park Full Day Safari

#### <u>About The Full Day Safari</u>

- With departure from the accommodation estimated at 5.30 am. This promises to be the climax of our wildlife experience. The Kruger National full Day safari!
- We will arrive at the nearest gate ready to be ushered early in the morning and experience wildlife at the various stages of the day. We will explore the park for the whole day with a quick pop in at the famous Skukuza Camp Located inside the Kruger National Park to have breakfast and lunch.
- Our day will end at around 4 pm when we will depart from the park and head back to our accommodation in Hazy View and reflect on the wonderful day we had.

## <u>Day 3</u>

### <u>About The Full Day Safari</u>

- This looks to be the pinnacle of our encounters with wildlife. On Day 3, we will go on a full-day safari to the Kruger National Park, exploring a different part of the park to get a better sense of the animals and perhaps even spot some new species.
- Early in the morning, we will arrive at the closest gate prepared to be escorted, and we will get to see wildlife at different times of the day.
- We will spend the entire day exploring the park, with a quick stop at the wellknown Skukuza, which is housed inside the Kruger, for breakfast and lunch.
- We will leave the park at approximately 4 p.m. and return to our overnight accommodation in Hazy View, where we can wrap up our fantastic day.

### About The Morning Safari

- We will rise early in the morning for our morning safari and get ready to jump inside the park as earliest as possible to get a feel of what this wildlife does in the wee hours of the morning.
- This also serves us an opportunity to see what wildlife does in the morning and especially the cat family who are always hunting their next meal. Various creatures will be coming back from hunts, and this will be the perfect time to see them in action. We will also get an opportunity to have our pre -packed breakfast prepared from the lodge and experience the best 4 hours in the morning.

1<u>0:00am-11:00am:</u> Return to overnight accommodation to collect luggage and check out.

<u>11:00-16:00 pm</u>: Travel from Kruger National Park (with one pit stop for bathroom and lunch at own cost at Middleburg) to Johannesburg.
