DETAILED ITINERARY

<u>Day 1 – Pick up -Travel to Mpumalanga-Afternoon</u> Safari

06:00am-7:00am: Pick up from your establishment in Johannesburg, Pretoria, and Sandton. 07:00am- 12:00am: Travel to Kruger National Park (with one pit stop for bathroom and coffee at own cost at Middleburg) Travelling to the Kruger National Park takes about 4 hours and 30 minutes. 12:00am-17:00pm: Kruger National Park Afternoon Safari

Upon traveling to Kruger National Park, you will be treated to the most beautiful scenery in Mpumalanga through meanders of wind and a beacon to look out the window and soak in the beauty of nature. Kruger National Park is located in the beautiful province of Mpumalanga in South Africa and is one of the biggest game reserves in Africa, home to the BIG 5: lion, buffalo, rhino, elephant, and leopards. Kruger National Park is the largest national park in South Africa and the first one to ever be established in 1926. Not only is it home to the big five, but it is also an epicentre for reptiles and bird life, having at least 517 bird species, 114 reptile species, and 147 large mammal species. Kruger National Park, besides being a haven for wildlife, is also home to not one but six different rivers that run through the park, such as the Sable, Olifants Crocodile, Letaba, Luvuvhu, and the Limpopo River, giving one backdrop and watering holes that animals frequently drink from. Enjoy this afternoon safari with a visit to Skukuza to grab a bit to eat before heading out to check into your overnight accommodation in Hazy View.

Day 2-Kruger National Park Full Day Safari

With departure from the accommodation estimated at 5.30 am. This promises to be the climax of our wildlife experience. The Kruger National full Day safari! An early morning safari provides an opportunity to see what wildlife does in the morning, particularly the cat family, which is constantly on the quest for their next meal. Various creatures will return from hunts, and this is the ideal time to witness them in action. We will arrive at the nearest gate, ready to be ushered early in the morning and experience wildlife at the various stages of the day. We will explore the park for the whole day with a quick popping to have breakfast and Lunch at the famous Skukuza Camp Located inside the Kruger National Park. Our day will end at around 4 pm when we depart from the park and head back to our accommodation in Hazy View and reflect on the wonderful day we had.

10:00am-11:00am: Return to overnight accommodation to collect luggage and check out. 11:00am-16:00pm: Travel from Kruger National Park (with one pit stop for bathroom and lunch at own cost at Middleburg) to Johannesburg Traveling to the Kruger National Park takes about 4 hours and 30 minutes.

Victoria Falls is the largest fall in the world at 108 meters (354 feet). It is known as "Mosi-oaTunya, "meaning the smoke that thunders. Victoria Falls was voted one of the seven wonders of the world and declared a UNESCO site in 1989. It serves as a border between Zimbabwe and Zambia. As soon as you enter the park, you will be embraced by the amazing sound of the rushing water down the edge of the falls. You will get to experience all the different sights of the falls. Vic Falls has 1–17 viewpoints on the Zimbabwe side. and with each viewpoint, you will experience different water pressures and views. You all go through all this while a tour guide explains the history of the falls and how they were discovered by the likes of David Livingstone. After the Victoria Falls tour, you will have the option to have lunch at the hotel or the local restaurant in town.

About Sunset Zambezi cruise

You will be picked up at the hotel by 16:00 p.m. to make your way to the harbour, where you will get on the boat that will take you on a spectacular sunset cruise. You will get to enjoy your afternoon on an open boat with amazing views of the river and the surrounding nature. You have a chance to also spot some hippos in their natural habitat. The boat will cross over to the Zambia side of the river to witness a breathtaking sunset while sipping local beverages and taking in the serene atmosphere.
