

Voortrekker Monument (Optional) – Pretoria

Paul Kruger House Museum – Pretoria



Church Square – Pretoria

Union Buildings – Pretoria

Apartheid Museum – Johannesburg

Constitution Hill (Optional) – Johannesburg

Explore the former prison complex at Constitution Hill, now a symbol of South Africa's commitment to human rights and justice. Optional stop to witness the transformation from a symbol of oppression to a beacon of hope.

Orlando Towers – Soweto

Arriving in Soweto, the Orlando Towers offer a mix of history and modernity.

Try an optional adrenaline-pumping bungee jump, or relax at Chef Pozi, a restaurant with panoramic views of the township.

Hector Pieterse Museum – Soweto

Visit the poignant Hector Pieterse Museum, dedicated to the young martyr of the 1976 Soweto Uprising.

This museum honours the brave students who fought against apartheid's oppressive policies.

Vilakazi Street – Soweto

Steeped in history, Vilakazi Street is the only street in the world to have housed two Nobel Laureates—Nelson Mandela and Desmond Tutu.

This vibrant street offers a mix of historical landmarks, local culture, and delicious food.

Mandela House Museum – Soweto

Step inside the humble home of Nelson Mandela, where he lived from 1946 until his imprisonment.

The house offers a personal glimpse into his life and the struggle for freedom, with bullet holes on the exterior as a reminder of the past.
